**GERARD ANDERSON ELECTED
TO McGREGOR FUND BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

The **McGregor Fund** is pleased to announce the election of **Gerard M. Anderson** to its Board of Trustees. Mr. Anderson will fill a vacancy created when Dave Bing stepped down after nine years of distinguished service, to serve a full term as Mayor of the City of Detroit.

Gerard M. Anderson is President and Chief Operating Officer of DTE Energy. Anderson oversees all of the company's electric, gas and nuclear operations, encompassed in its two main operating subsidiaries, Detroit Edison and MichCon, as well as its non-utility businesses, which are focused on power and industrial projects, natural gas pipelines and storage, energy trading, and unconventional gas production. He has been the architect and leader of the company's strategy to develop its non-regulated businesses and its focus on cost and operational excellence in the utility businesses. He is a member of the board of directors of The Andersons, a diversified public company focused on agricultural markets. He is also involved in various local community and civic activities, serving as vice chairman of The Nature Conservancy, Michigan chapter; chairman of the Michigan Greenways Initiative; and as a member of the Executive Committee of The Parade Company. He also serves on the Henry Ford Board of Trustees. Mr. Anderson resides in Ann Arbor.
